

TRANSPORT — TREENDALE–MILLBRIDGE BRIDGE

4410. Hon Sally Talbot to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Transport:

I refer to construction of the Treendale–Millbridge Bridge, and I ask:

- (a) which companies tendered for the project:
 - (i) of the companies in (a), which of these have a head office in the South West region; and
 - (ii) which company was awarded the contract;
- (b) what proportion of the bridge infrastructure will be sourced domestically; and
- (c) when is the construction stage of the project expected to commence?

Hon Jim Chown replied:

Main Roads Western Australia advises:

As at 21 September 2016

- (a) The following companies submitted tenders for the contract: BGC Contracting Pty Ltd, BMD Constructions Pty Ltd, Bocol Construction Pty Ltd, CPB Contractors, Georgiou Group Pty Ltd, Geotech Pty Ltd, Highway / Albem JV, NV Besix SA and York Civil Pty Ltd.
 - (i) None of the nine companies have a head office in the South West Region.
 - (ii) The Contract has not been awarded yet because the tender assessment process has not been completed.
- (b) This information cannot be determined until the tender assessment process is completed.
- (c) Construction of the bridge is expected to commence in late 2016.
