## PORT HEDLAND VOLUNTARY BUYBACK SCHEME

## 528. Hon COLIN de GRUSSA to the Leader of the House representing the Minister for Ports:

I refer to the Port Hedland buyback scheme.

- (1) Since the start of the scheme
  - (a) how many first offers have been made;
  - (b) how many first offers were rejected; and
  - (c) how many rejected offers were renegotiated and subsequently accepted?
- (2) What is the total cost to date?
- (3) Can the minister confirm that short-stay accommodation venues are not eligible for the scheme; and, if yes, will any changes be made to cater for accommodation venues?

## Hon SUE ELLERY replied:

I thank the honourable member for some notice of the question.

- (1) (a) There are 105 owners who have received offer outline letters.
  - (b) Three first offers were rejected.
  - (c) Nil.
- (2) The total cost is approximately \$15.17 million.
- (3) Yes, short-stay accommodation venues are not eligible for the scheme, and no changes will be made to cater for accommodation venues.
