

ROAD SAFETY — RUN-OFF-ROAD CRASH RISK

641. Hon SALLY TALBOT to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Transport:

- (1) Which roads have been identified as having an above average run-off-road crash risk in —
- (a) the Shire of Collie;
 - (b) the Shire of Dardanup;
 - (c) the Shire of Capel;
 - (d) the Shire of Manjimup;
 - (e) the Shire of Denmark; and
 - (f) the City of Bunbury?
- (2) Has work on any of these roads been put on hold due to the cuts to the run-off-road program?

- (a) Sections of Coalfields highway, Patstone Road and Mornington Road.
 - (b) Sections of South Western Highway, Forrest Highway and Ferguson Road.

 - (d) Sections of Pemberton Northcliffe Road, South Western Highway, Vasse Highway, Wheatley Coast Road and Graphite Road.
 - (e) Sections of South Western Highway.
 - (f) Sections of Forrest Highway and South Western Highway.
