530. Hon SALLY TALBOT to the Minister for Indigenous Affairs:

Does the minister support the comments attributed to outgoing Western Australian Liberal Party state president Barry Court that the Aboriginal flag and welcome to country ceremonies are unnecessary?

Hon PETER COLLIER replied:
