517. Hon MARTIN PRITCHARD to the Attorney General representing the Minister for Police:

I refer to a frightening incident that allegedly occurred on a Transperth bus in Como on Thursday, 12 May 2016, and reports of serious charges being laid against a 28-year-old Kenwick man.

- (1) When were police first called to this serious incident?
- (2) When did police first attend?
- (3) Were there any earlier calls to police regarding the behaviour of the man who has been charged?
- (4) If yes to (3), what time was each call and what was the police response?
