## NATIONAL BROADBAND NETWORK TOWER — MANDURAH

## 850. Hon SALLY TALBOT to the minister representing the Minister for Planning:

- (1) Is the minister aware of the strong opposition by a number of residents in the Bouvard area of Mandurah to the installation of a 40-metre high NBN wireless broadband tower on the boundary of the Yalgorup National Park?
- (2) Is the minister aware that the Mandurah City Council planning committee has recommended unanimously that the full council reject the application for the tower construction?
- (3) Given that residents' concerns include health impacts, noncompliance with town planning minimum setbacks, the threat to areas of natural conservation and the visual amenity of the area, and that colocation to a nearby telecommunication site has not been sufficiently explored, does the minister agree that state planning policy 5.2 on telecommunications infrastructure is in need of review and revision?
- (4) If no to (3), why not?
- (5) If yes, to (3), will the minister undertake such a review, and when?
