

AT RISK YOUTH STRATEGY REVIEW AND IMPLEMENTATION PLAN

841. Hon SALLY TALBOT to the Minister for Child Protection:

I refer to the “Department for Child Protection: At Risk Youth Strategy: 2011–2014” report published by the Department for Child Protection in December 2011 and to the statement at the end of that document, which states —

The 16 actions outlined in the Strategy will be implemented initially through the development of the *At Risk Youth Strategy Review and Implementation Plan* ... The Plan will provide a current status of each action and the proposed activities for achieving them.

- (1) Has the at risk youth strategy review and implementation plan been finalised?
- (2) If not, why not; and, when will it be finalised?
- (3) If yes to (1), where is the current status of each action identified in the strategy and the proposed activities for achieving them to be found?
- (4) Will the minister table the details of the current status of each action and the associated proposed activities for achieving them?
- (5) If no to (4), why not?

Hon HELEN MORTON replied:
