32. Hon SALLY TALBOT to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Transport:

- (1) How many run-off-road crashes occurred on the 93-kilometre section of South Western Highway between the Pemberton turnoff and Walpole in
 - (a) 2013;
 - (b) 2014; and
 - (c) 2015 to date?
- (2) Have community consultations about options to widen this section of highway been concluded?
- (3) If no to (2), what further consultations are planned?
- (4) If yes to (2), what were the results of the consultation?
- (5) What funding was allocated to this project in 2014–15?
- What funding is required to undertake the safety improvements that the community is rightly demanding, and when will this work be undertaken?

- (1) (a) There were 11 crashes in 2013.
 - (b) There were eight crashes in 2014.
 - (c) Data is currently unavailable.
- (2) No.
- (3) Further meetings with the community consultation group will be held as required.
- (4) Not applicable.
- (5) An allocation of \$75 000 has been made for project development.
- (6) Approximately \$40 million is required to undertake the improvements.
