## GREENOUGH REGIONAL PRISON — DEPARTMENT REVIEWS

6380. Mr I.C. Blayney to the Minister for Corrective Services:

I refer to the answer to Question on Notice 5578 in relation to the Education, Employment and Transitional Services Review, and the Prison Services Evaluation Project, and I ask:

- (a) Have these reviews been finalised:
  - (i) If so, please table the review, and outline the outcomes of the review;
  - (ii) If no, why not; and
  - (iii) If no, can the Minister outline a time frame for when the reviews are expected to be complete?

## Mr F.M. Logan replied:

- (a) No.
  - (i)–(iii) The Education, Employment and Transition Services (ETTS) review is underway. Due to Covid-19 and competing priorities, recommendations have not yet been considered by the Department for finalisation.

It is expected to be reviewed during quarter 4 2020. This will include consideration of which recommendations are to be supported and prioritised for implementation.

The Prison Services Evaluation (PSE Project) is yet to be finalised. The PSE is to occur in three stages which is expected to be finalised for consideration by Government and implementation in 2021.
