 - one (1) from the Department of Justice.
 - (b)–(d) This level of information is not readily available from the Department of Communities' child protection information system as the information is held on individual case files. It would impose a significant administrative burden to source and collate this data.

 - (a) Of these 35 agreements, a total of 18 originated from another State Government Department:
 - seven (7) from the Department of Education;
 - six (6) from the Western Australia Police Force;
