994. Hon MARTIN PRITCHARD to the Attorney General representing the Minister for Police:

I refer to the case of a 17-year-old who was sentenced last week in relation to a hooning incident in Darch that led to the injury of, and amputation to, bystander Taylah Parry.

- (1) Can the Minister for Police confirm that the offender was a prior offender?
- (2) Can minister confirm that prior to this incident, a warrant was due to be served in relation to this individual?
- (3) Can the minister advise why that warrant had not been served?

Hon MICHAEL MISCHIN replied:

On behalf of the Minister for Police, I thank the honourable member for some notice of the question.

- (1)–(3) Due to the provisions of the Young Offenders Act 1994, it is not appropriate to provide any comment about the juvenile's previous offences, if any.
