(1)–(2) Data as at 30 September 2020:

	Number of students (Headcount)	Number of students with a disability, as a percentage of funded students
Primary School	28 043	13.9%
Secondary School	14 741	12.9%

Percentages are based on funded student headcount for students enrolled in Kindergarten to Year 10, and FTE for students enrolled in Years 11 and 12 at the February student census.

	Number of students (Headcount)	Number of students with a disability, as a percentage of funded students
Primary School	24 290	12.6%
Secondary School	13 600	13.3%
