

WALPOLE AND NORNALUP INLETS MARINE PARK — COORDINATOR

**791. Hon SALLY TALBOT to the minister representing the Minister for Environment:**

I refer to the Walpole and Nornalup Inlets Marine Park coordinator.

- (1) Has this position been cut?
- (2) If yes to (1), who is now responsible for the coordination of the Walpole and Nornalup Inlets Marine Park?
- (3) Has the employee who held the position been redeployed?
- (4) Have the coordinator positions in any of the other marine parks in Western Australian been cut; and, if so, which ones?

**Hon HELEN MORTON replied:**

I thank the member for some notice of this question. The Minister for Environment has provided the following response.

- (1) Yes. The position was abolished on 2 July 2015.
- (2) The Department of Parks and Wildlife's Frankland district manager is now the responsible officer.
- (3) No. The occupant is being managed as per the Public Sector Management (Redeployment and Redundancy) Regulations 2014.
