ROAD SAFETY — TRAFFIC CONTROL

4354. Mr P.A. Katsambanis to the Minister for Police; Road Safety:

I refer to Police traffic control, and ask:

- (a) how many hours of traffic control were undertaken by the Western Australian Police Force in each of the years 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and as of 25 October 2018;
- (b) how many speeding infringement notices were issued in school 40km/hr school zones in each of the years 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 and as of 25 October 2018; and
- (c) for each of the years above what was the highest vehicle speed recorded?

Mrs M.H. Roberts replied:

The Western Australian Police Force advised the following:

- (a) Traffic control hours are not recorded by the WA Police Force.
- (b) The number of speeding infringement notices issued in school zones from January 1 2013 to 25 October 2018 inclusive are 40,608; 38,162; 37,450; 31,025; 38,252; and 31,410 respectively. This includes some offences detected in school zones where the school zone speed limit is something other than 40km/h.
- (c) The highest speed in a school zone in km/h recorded for each of these years was 93; 95; 84; 83; 84 and 82.
