

MINISTER FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES — STAFF — PUBLIC INTEREST DISCLOSURE ACT

5933. Mr Z.R.F. Kirkup to the Minister for Emergency Services; Corrective Services:

Since 11 March 2017, has any officer within any of the Minister's agencies, departments, government trading enterprises or boards submitted a Public Interest Disclosure (PID) form consistent with the *Public Interest Disclosure Act 2003*, and if so:

- (a) In 2017 how many related to:
 - (i) Improper conduct;
 - (ii) An offence under written State law;
 - (iii) Substantial unauthorised or irregular use of, or substantial mismanagement of, public resources; and
 - (iv) Conduct involving a substantial and specific risk of injury to public health, or prejudice to public safety or harm to the environment;
- (b) In 2018 how many related to:
 - (i) Improper conduct;
 - (ii) An offence under written State law;
 - (iii) Substantial unauthorised or irregular use of, or substantial mismanagement of, public resources; and
 - (iv) Conduct involving a substantial and specific risk of injury to public health, or prejudice to public safety or harm to the environment; and
- (c) In 2019 how many related to:
 - (i) Improper conduct;
 - (ii) An offence under written State law;
 - (iii) Substantial unauthorised or irregular use of, or substantial mismanagement of, public resources; and
 - (iv) Conduct involving a substantial and specific risk of injury to public health, or prejudice to public safety or harm to the environment?
