

PUBLIC SECTOR RECRUITMENT FREEZE — UNDER TREASURER'S ADVICE

**225. Hon MARTIN PRITCHARD to the Attorney General representing the Minister for Police:**

I refer to the Treasurer's answer to question without notice 112 asked on 24 February 2016.

- (1) How many requests for approval for exemptions from the public sector recruitment freeze have been lodged by the Minister for Police since the freeze began on 21 December 2015?
- (2) For each exemption request —
  - (a) for what agency was the request made;
  - (b) when was it lodged;
  - (c) when was it granted; and
  - (d) what is the position title and salary?
