- (3) If yes to (2), please identify those individuals and indicate how much they were paid for their participation as members of the advisory body over the current term of Government?
- (4) Please indicate if any of the people who received payment were public servants?
- (5) If yes to (4), please identify those individuals?
- (6) Please indicate if any of the people who received payment were union officials?
- (7) If yes to (6), please identify those individuals?

Hon Sue Ellery replied:

It is unclear what the Honourable Member means by 'advisory body'. It is unclear whether he is referring to Boards, Committees or other informal advisory groups that are formed on an ad hoc basis to advise Ministers of specific issues; or a combination of all three.

If the Honourable Member would like to ask a more specific question or clarify what he means by 'Advisory Bodies', the Premier will endeavour to answer the question.
