I refer to material from insurance company Youi being included with official correspondence from the Department of Transport.

- (1) Is the government aware that Youi is currently being investigated by the Australian Securities and Investments Commission?
- (2) Could the minister please provide the full financial details of the government's advertising partnership with Youi?
- (3) Does the government intend to renew the partnership, given the ASIC investigation?

Hon MICHAEL MISCHIN replied:

I thank the honourable member for some notice of the question. I provide the following answer on behalf of the Leader of the House representing the Minister for Transport.

- (1) No
- (2) The government does not have a partnership with Youi. The Department of Transport has a contract with a company that sources advertising material for inclusion in outgoing vehicle renewal notices.
