

AQUACULTURE LICENCES — ALBANY

**610. Hon COLIN de GRUSSA to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Fisheries:**

I refer to the government inviting applications for aquaculture licences and leases within the Albany Aquaculture Development Zone in the Oyster Harbour area.

- (1) How many applications were received and assessed by the Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development?
- (2) Have any licences or leases been approved; and, if so, how many, and to whom?
- (3) Were all applications assessed in full compliance with *Administrative guideline no. 1, 2017: Assessment of applications for authorisations for aquaculture and pearling in coastal waters of Western Australia*?
- (4) If no to (3), why not?

**Hon SAMANTHA ROWE replied:**

I thank the member for some notice of the question, and provide the following answer on behalf of the parliamentary secretary who represents the Minister for Fisheries.

- (1) Four, one of which has since been withdrawn. The remaining three are being assessed by the department.
- (2) No new licences or leases have been approved since the declaration of the Oyster Harbour area.
- (3) Yes, the applications are being assessed in accordance with the relevant legislation and administrative guidelines.
