

CHILDREN AND COMMUNITY SERVICES ACT 2004 — LEGISLATIVE REVIEW

**528. Hon SALLY TALBOT to the Minister for Child Protection:**

I refer to the report of the legislative review of the Children and Community Services Act 2004, tabled in the Legislative Council on 29 November 2012.

- (1) Is the minister preparing a response to the report; and, if so, when will the response be available?
- (2) If no to (1), why not?
- (3) Is the minister planning amendments to the act in line with the recommendations of the report; and, if so, will community sector stakeholders be consulted about the amendments, and when will this consultation take place?
- (4) If amendments to the act are not being planned, why not?
