Can the Minister please advise how much funding was provided for each of the following police community programs over the last five years:

- (a) the Armed Robbery Prevention Program;
- (b) the Blue Light Program;
- (c) community safety crime prevention plans;
- (d) the Constable Care Child Safety Foundation;
- (e) the Keeping Kids in School Program;
- (f) police and community youth centres;
- (g) the Police Ranger Program; and
- (h) the SAY Project; and the ThinkUKnow Program?
