**Transcript of Evidence – 2015/16 Budget Estimates Hearing**

I wish to inform the Committee of incorrect factual information that I inadvertently provided at the 25 June 2015 hearing for the Department of Transport.

The information relates to a response I gave on the number of Multi-Purpose Taxi (MPT) plates and is contained on page 12 of the attached transcript of evidence. In my evidence, I stated that:

*“...In terms of the number of multi-purpose taxi plates, there are three categories: restricted hours for peak period sedans, 370; restricted hours for peak period vans is 40; and restricted-area taxis, which is Swan and Kalamunda, is 16. These are the numbers of MPT plates that match our revenue estimates for the 2015-16 Budget.”*

Whilst those numbers are correct, the categories I referred to are not categories of MPTs. The number of MPT plates currently in operation is 110 in the metropolitan area and 37 in regional areas.

I apologise for the error.
