COMMITTEE'S FUNCTIONS AND POWERS

Legislative Assembly Standing Order No. 284 provides the following functions, powers and terms of reference to the Procedure and Privileges Committee -

Procedure and Privileges Committee

- 284. (1) A Procedure and Privileges Committee will be appointed at the beginning of each Parliament to -
 - (a) examine and report on the procedures of the Assembly; and
 - (b) examine and report on issues of privilege; and
 - (c) wherever necessary, confer with a similar committee of the Council.
 - (2) Membership of the committee will consist of the Speaker and four other members as the Assembly appoints.
 - (3) Standing Order 278 will apply except that where possible any report of the committee will be presented by the Deputy Speaker.
 - (4) When consideration of a report from the committee is set down as an order of the day it will be considered using the consideration in detail procedure.

REPORT

The Speaker of the Legislative Assembly referred to the Procedure and Privileges Committee a letter dated 10 December 2008 from Mr Robert (Bob) Falconer, seeking to use Standing Order 114 to respond to comments made on 27 November 2008 by the Member for Mindarie, Mr John Quigley.

RESPONSE BY MR ROBERT (BOB) FALCONER

AGREED TO BY MR ROBERT (BOB) FALCONER AND THE PROCEDURE AND PRIVILEGES COMMITTEE PURSUANT TO STANDING ORDER 114

It has come to my attention that on 27 November 2008 in the Legislative Assembly the member for Mindarie, Mr J R Quigley, made an untrue assertion in relation to actions he attributed to me in the role of WA Police Commissioner.
