

## **Mental Health Ministers of Western Australia**

On the 4 February 2010, Premier Barnett announced the creation of a new department, the Mental Health Commission, to lead mental health reform throughout the State. The Commission became effective on 8 March 2010. The Commission was created initially by transferring existing resources of the Mental Health Division of the Department of Health. Its focus is on mental health strategic policy; planning; procurement and performance monitoring; and evaluation of services.
