

## **Works Ministers of Western Australia**

The first Works Ministry was established as the Director of Public Works in the Forrest Government in 1890. It changed to the Minister for Works in the Leake Oppositionist Government, 1901. There have been 43 Ministers for Works in 33 Governments. William James George was responsible for the Works Ministry in four different governments over eight years.
