# Criminal Code Amendment (Protection of Seniors) Bill 2000

#### An Act to amend The Criminal Code.

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

# 1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Criminal Code Amendment* (Protection of Seniors) Act 2000.

#### 5 2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

#### 4. Section 318 amended

Section 318 is amended by adding a new paragraph (h) to subsection (1) as follows —

or

(h) assaults a person of or over the age of 60 years;

#### 5. Section 393 amended

Section 393 is amended by adding a new paragraph as follows —

If the offender robs a person of or over the age of 60 years, he is liable to imprisonment for 20 years.

#### 20 **6. Section 400 amended**

Section 400 is amended by adding a new paragraph (vii) to subsection (1)(a) as follows —

(vii) the burglary was committed against a person of or over the age of 60 years;

# 7. Section 409 amended

Section 409 is amended by adding the following words after "liable to imprisonment for 7 years" as follows —

"

Provided that where the fraud is committed against a natural person and that person is of or over the age of 60 years, the offender is liable to imprisonment for 10 years
