# Free Range Eggs Labelling Bill 2012

### **EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

#### Clause 1: Short title

The short title is the *Free Range Eggs Labelling Act 2012*.

#### **Clause 2: Commencement**

The Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives Royal Assent.

#### **Clause 3: Definitions**

Clause 3 defines relevant terms.

### Clause 4: Free range egg labelling requirements

Clause 4 provides that the packaging for free range eggs must be labelled with the words "free range" conspicuously in standard type at least 6mm high.

## Clause 5: Labelling of egg packages

Packages containing eggs that are not free range eggs (as that term is defined in Clause 3) may not be labelled as free range. The maximum penalty for non-compliance is 50 penalty units, imprisonment for 6 months or both.

## Clause 6: Display of Free-range eggs for retail sale

Clause 6 requires that a person who displays free-range eggs for retail sale must display a sign in the specified way saying "These eggs are free range eggs. They are produced by birds in free-range systems that comply with the minimum standards in the Code of Practice for Poultry in Western Australia". The maximum penalty for non-compliance is 50 penalty units.

# **Clause 7: Regulations**

Clause 9 is the regulation-making power.

**Schedule 1** sets out the conditions in which free range hens are kept for the purposes of the definition of "free range hen".
