A Bill for

An Act to dedicate the Heathcote Hospital site as a Class A reserve and for related purposes.

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Heathcote Hospital Site* (*Reservation*) *Act 2001*.

This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

3. Interpretation

In this Act —

"land" means the land described in the Schedule and commonly known as the "Heathcote Hospital site";

"Minister" has the meaning it is given under section 7 of the *Land Administration Act 1997*.

4. Land vested as a class A reserve

Upon the commencement of this Act, the land is subject to Part 4 of the *Land Administration Act 1997* and the Minister, acting under that Part, is required to reserve the land to the Crown as a class A reserve for the purpose of providing public open space.

5. Use of land or buildings subject to Heritage Agreement

- (1) Use of the land must not contravene the provisions of any Heritage Agreement that is the subject of a memorial entered on the title under Part 4 of the *Heritage of Western Australia Act* 1990.
- (2) In this section, "land" includes any building any work carried out on the land or to a building.
