# **Superannuation and Family Benefits Amendment Bill 1999**

An Act to amend the Superannuation and Family Benefits Act 1938.

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

## 1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Superannuation and Family Benefits Amendment Act 1999.

## 2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation on the day it receives the Royal Assent.

## 5 **3.** Principal Act

In this Act the *Superannuation and Family Benefits Act 1938\** is referred to as the principal Act.

## 4. Schedule 6 amended

- (1) Part I of Schedule 6 of the principal Act is amended by
  - (a) deleting "widow" wherever occurring and substituting the following
    - " widow or widower ";
  - (b) deleting "husband" wherever occurring and substituting the following
    - " husband or wife ";
  - (c) deleting "he" wherever occurring and substituting the following
    - " he or she ":
  - (d) deleting "she" wherever occurring and substituting the following
    - " she or he ";
  - (e) deleting "his" wherever occurring and substituting the following
    - " his or her "; and

- (f) deleting "her" wherever occurring and substituting the following
  - " her or him ".
- (2) Items 4 and 5 in Part I of Schedule 6 of the principal Act are repealed.

## 5. Transitional

- (1) This Act applies to a person who becomes a widower on or after the day on which this Act comes into operation.
- (2) Where a person becomes a widower immediately before the commencement of this Act, Schedule 6 of the principal Act applies as if this Act had not been passed.
