Clarification of Transcript – please note these clarifications should be considered alongside the slides which will be published on the website.

1. Page 2 Draft Transcript - In this sentence I was talking to the slide on the severity of symptoms experienced by patients, and contrasting the column on symptoms of moderate severity with the column on symptoms of greater severity. So I was not talking about moderate severity as such (as Hansard would have it) but *symptoms* of moderate severity. The contrast is lost if “symptoms” is not added after “moderate severity”.
2. Page 11 Draft Transcript - A contrast is being drawn here between two groups of people with progressive medical conditions: the first group (“these people”) refers back to those with “so-called progressive neurological conditions” mentioned at the beginning of the paragraph, while the second group is people who have more progressive conditions. The contrast is lost unless the word “more” is included.
3. Page 12 Draft Transcript - At this point a slide was shown, and in the next paragraph I am talking to it. Perhaps the Hansard record could show that a slide was shown, so that the next paragraph can make more sense.
