The inquiry into end of life choices

The Committee inquiring into End of Life Choices will be conducting its last public hearings on Friday, 18 May 2018. At the hearings, the Committee will hear evidence from the Australian Medical Association (WA) about its recent End of Life Symposium for members and from key representatives of the Department of Health.

The Committee Chair, Ms Amber-Jade Sanderson MLA, stated:

The Committee inquiring into End of Life Choices will have had 81 public hearing sessions by Friday. The transcripts and many video-recordings are available from our website as well as more than 650 submissions that interested individuals and organisations gave to us.

The level of participation and interest in our inquiry reflects the importance of these issues for our community. These are literally matters of life and death and people have responded accordingly. The Committee is grateful to those who have been prepared to contribute so much to our inquiry, in particular witnesses who have willingly shared their very personal and profound experiences with Committee members and the public.

From now until August, the focus of the Committee will be on deliberating upon and finalising the inquiry report.
