3. Economic hardship during the COVID-19 crisis

Hon Aaron Stonehouse: To move —

That the Legislative Council —

- (a) recognises the economic hardship felt by Western Australians during the COVID-19 crisis:
- (b) condemns the Government for exacerbating this hardship by continuing to tax Western Australians into unemployment and penury; and
- (c) calls upon the Government to immediately return the money of hard-working Western Australians through a series of aggressive tax cuts.
