

NON-GOVERNMENT BUSINESS

1. Climate Change and Greenhouse Gas Emissions Reduction Bill 2021 (Notice given 12 October 2021)

Hon Dr Brad Pettitt: To move —

That a Bill for "An Act to provide for —

- targets for the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions and the increase in renewable energy generation; and
- the establishment of the Climate Change Council, and for related purposes." be introduced and read a first time.

2. Climate Change

Hon Dr Brad Pettitt: To move —

That this House notes:

- (a) the Paris Climate Agreement, the latest IPCC reports, other associated climate science, and the implications of their recommendations for addressing climate changes here in Western Australia and across the globe;
- (b) the economic opportunities that an ambitious transition to a low carbon economy creates for Western Australia; and
- (c) that Western Australia is the only Australian state with rising carbon emissions and one of the few Australian states to not have legislated targets for reducing carbon emissions and calls on the Western Australian Government to:
 - develop as a priority (and bring back to this Parliament) a legislated target for reaching net zero carbon emissions and an interim target for 2030 that is consistent with the latest IPCC report and associated climate science; and
 - (ii) set up a climate expert panel to advise Government with transparent and regular reporting mechanisms to the Parliament.
