I refer to my question without notice 464 on 11 August 2023 regarding the Renewable Energy Buyback Scheme, and I ask, for each of the financial years 2021-22 and 2022-23:

- (a) how many residential rooftop solar systems have been installed in Western Australia; and
- (b) what is the total amount of energy purchased through the scheme?

 - (ii) from 27 November 2018 to 17 August 2020; and

 - (i) the name of the project;
 - (ii) date of application;
 - (iii) outcome of application; and
 - (iv) the position of the Premier of the day on each application?

I refer to the Government's proposed plan to further restrict law-abiding firearm licence holders, and I ask:

- (a) if the key objective is public safety, in the most recent data available how many firearms related offences were committed using licensed firearms;

- (c) is there any visible trend over recent years; and
- (d) if yes to (c), what is the trend?
