THURSDAY, 11 JUNE 2020

1. Meeting of Council

The Council assembled at 10.00am pursuant to order.

The President, Hon Kate Doust, took the Chair.

Prayers and an Acknowledgement of Country were read.

2. Agricultural Produce Commission Amendment Bill 2019

The Minister for Regional Development moved, without notice —

- (1) That the *Agricultural Produce Commission Amendment Bill 2019* be discharged and referred to the Standing Committee on Legislation for consideration and report by no later than 17 September 2020.
- (2) The Committee has the power to inquire into and report on the policy of the Bill. Question put and passed.

3. Exploration Incentive Scheme

Non-Government Business No. 1 having been called, Hon Colin de Grussa moved, without notice — That this House recognises that the Exploration Incentive Scheme creates jobs and delivers a significant net benefit to the Western Australian economy and calls on the McGowan Government to immediately increase funding of the Exploration Incentive Scheme to at least \$15 million per annum.

Debate ensued.

4. Manufacturing Jobs in Western Australia

Private Members' Business No. 1 having been called, Hon Pierre Yang moved, without notice —

That the Legislative Council recognise the effort of the McGowan Government in creating manufacturing jobs for Western Australians and encourage the Federal Government to work with the State Government so more manufacturing jobs in all sectors can be created for Western Australians.

Debate ensued.

5. Protection of Aboriginal and Archaeological Sites

Hon Robin Chapple sought leave to give a late notice of motion.

Leave granted.

Hon Robin Chapple: To move on the next day of sitting —

That this Legislative Council debate the failure of the Nation and the State of Western Australia to protect some of the world's oldest Aboriginal and archaeological sites and proffer ideas to improve the situation.
