- (1) Regarding the 2012–2013 financial year for the native forest logging industry, excluding sandalwood, what was the total amount paid by the Forest Products Commission (FPC) to contractors engaged in the native forest logging industry?
 - (2) What was the cost to the FPC itself for its engagement in the native forest logging industry?
 - (3) How much did the FPC pay to:
 - (a) the Department of Parks and Wildlife for its involvement in the native forest logging industry; and
 - (b) the Conservation Commission for its involvement in the native forest logging industry?
