

REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT COMMISSIONS — CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICERS

138. Hon MARTIN ALDRIDGE to the Leader of the House representing the Premier:

I refer to the state government's machinery of government reforms.

- (1) What advice has the Public Sector Commission provided to the chief executive officers of the nine regional development commissions on their tenure in that capacity?
- (2) Has the Public Sector Commission advised the regional development commissions that the chief executive officers will cease to hold that position as of 30 June 2017?
- (3) Has the Public Sector Commission asked the chief executive officers of regional development commissions to continue in any other capacity post 30 June 2017?
