

PUBLIC TRANSPORT — SPECIALIST ADVICE PROVISION

4786. Hon Ken Travers to the Minister for Finance representing the Minister for Transport
- (1) Will the Minister table the following studies —
 - (a) Syme Marmion — provision of specialist advice of specific funding options;
 - (b) CATALYST — Valuing Public Transport with Benefit–Cost Analysis;
 - (c) Curtin University — application of the Spatial Network Analysis for Multi Modal Urban Transport Systems tool; and
 - (d) ARUP — provision of specialist advice on specific funding options?
 - (2) If no to (1)(a), (b), (c) or (d), why not?
 - (3) Will the Minister table any concept design or strategies or technical reports on any light rail proposal?
 - (4) If no to (3), why not?
 - (5) Will the Minister table any modelling on patronage numbers used in developing the ‘Public Transport for Perth in 2031’?
 - (6) If no to (5), why not?

Hon SIMON O’BRIEN replied:

- (1)–(6) Cabinet is yet to consider specific funding, plans and concepts of some of the content contained in the 2031 plan and it would therefore be premature to release these documents.
