

KIMBERLEY SUICIDES — CORONER'S REPORT — GOVERNMENT RESPONSE

**512. Hon NICK GOIRAN to the Leader of the House representing the Minister for Child Protection:**

I refer to the coroner's inquest into 13 deaths of children and young people in the Kimberley region, which was delivered more than three months ago and contained 42 recommendations.

- (1) Is the minister coordinating the whole-of-government response?
- (2) If no to (1), who is?
- (3) Further to (2), has the minister had any involvement in the response?
- (4) If yes to (1) or (3), in which calendar month is the government currently planning to provide its response?

**Hon SUE ELLERY replied:**

- (2) The Deputy Premier and Minister for Health, Hon Roger Cook, MLA.

- (4) The government has not yet settled on a specific release date; however, work is being progressed.
