Government Response — Statement by Minister for Police

HARVEY (Scarborough — Minister for Police) [9.02 am]: On 14 June this year, the Community Development and Justice Standing Committee tabled its report titled, “Review of the police investigation into traffic incidents involving a Member of Parliament”, which sought a response from the government through the Minister for Police. Although I note that the committee’s report contained a majority report and two minority reports, the government’s response addresses findings and recommendations contained in the majority report. The government’s response comprises a letter from me, as Minister for Police, and supporting documents from the Commissioner of Police and the State Solicitor. I hereby table the government’s response to this report.
