

DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING — PROPERTIES — THORNLIE AND GOSNELLS

2929. Mr C.J. Tallentire to the Minister for Housing:

- (1) Will the Minister provide the addresses and descriptions of properties purchased by the Department of Housing in each of the suburbs of Thornlie and Gosnells for each financial year: 2011–2012, 2012–2013, and 2013–2014?
- (2) How many properties does the Department of Housing intend to purchase in each of the suburbs of Thornlie and Gosnells between now and the end of the 2016–2017 financial year?

Mr W.R. Marmion replied:

The Department of Housing advises:

- (1) Six dwellings, consisting of five three-bedroom and one four-bedroom, in Gosnells and none in Thornlie in 2011–2012.
One two-bedroom dwelling in Gosnells and none in Thornlie in 2012–2013.
One two-bedroom dwelling in Gosnells and none in Thornlie in 2013–2014.
The addresses and property descriptions are publically available from Landgate.
- (2) The Department may purchase properties in the future, depending on available funding, and specific locations will be based on demand and priorities at the time. Therefore, the Department is unable to provide details on possible future purchases in these particular suburbs.
