

INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT ON IDENTITY MATCHING SERVICES

**586. Hon SIMON O'BRIEN to the Leader of the House representing the Premier:**

I refer to the Intergovernmental Agreement on Identity Matching Services of 5 October 2017, clause 5.5 of which states —

The private sector will not be given access to the other Face Matching Services or the Identity Data Sharing Service.

- (1) Will private companies be able to use the identification systems contemplated in the agreement to establish the identity of, for example, the owners or drivers of vehicles?
- (2) Will any local government be able to access the identity matching systems?

**Hon SUE ELLERY replied:**
