

EDUCATION — TOTAL COST OF SERVICES — COMMONWEALTH-STATE CONTRIBUTION

531. Hon DONNA FARAGHER to the Minister for Education and Training:

I refer to the total cost of services for the education portfolio identified in the “Appropriations, Expenses and Cash Assets” table on page 311 of the 2019–20 budget paper No 2, volume 1. For each of the financial years 2019–20, 2020–21, 2021–22 and 2022–23, will the minister provide a breakdown of the funding provided by the state and commonwealth governments?
