

QUEENSLAND FLY IN, FLY OUT INQUIRY REPORT

1252. Hon ROBIN CHAPPLE to the minister representing the Minister for Mines and Petroleum:

I refer to the inquiry into fly in, fly out and other long distance commuting work practices in regional Queensland, and the ninth report tabled in the Queensland Parliament on 9 October 2015.
