

DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND CONSERVATION — RESTRUCTURE

1550. Mr C.J. Tallentire to the Minister for Environment:

I refer to the changes to the Department of Environment and Conservation, which has been split into the Department of Environmental Regulation and the Department of Parks and Wildlife, and ask:

- (a) how many offices require new signage to accommodate the new title of each department; and
- (b) how many pollution response vehicles require new signage to accommodate the new title of each department?

Mr A.P. Jacob replied:

For the Department of Parks and Wildlife (DPaW)

- (a) Of the 73 office locations throughout the state, 24 have had new signs put in place. For the purposes of this answer the department's Kensington and Bentley sites have each been treated as a single location.
- (b) Not applicable.

For the Department of Environment Regulation (DER)

- (a) Eleven offices require new signage.
- (b) Nine DER vehicles require new signage.
