

LEGAL AFFAIRS — DRUG CONVICTIONS

4689. Mr P. Papalia to the Minister representing the Attorney General:

- (1) In 2014 how many adults were convicted of an offence or offences involving:
  - (a) drug use;
  - (b) drug possession; and
  - (c) dealing/trafficking?
- (2) For each of the categories above:
  - (a) how many were sentenced between 12 and 24 months;
  - (b) how many were sentenced between 24 and 36 months; and
  - (c) how many were sentenced between 36 and 48 months?
- (3) for each of the categories above, how many offenders had crystal methamphetamine use, possession or dealing as a component of their offence; and?
- (4) for each of the categories above, how many offenders had crystal methamphetamine dealing to a child as a component of their offence?

- (2) For “drug use” (a) 0; (b) 0 and (c) 0  
For “drug possession:” (a) 1, (b) 0 and (c) 0  
For “dealing/trafficking” (a) 204, (b) 98 and (c) 79
- (3)–(4) The type of drug is not recorded in the electronic data system.
