

SCHOOLS — BANKSIA GROVE PRIMARY — MAINTENANCE

5304. Ms R. Saffioti to the minister representing the Minister for Education:

With reference to Banksia Grove Primary School:

- (a) what is the current estimated value of maintenance required;
- (b) what are the details of maintenance required;
- (c) have funds been allocated for such maintenance; and
- (d) if not, when will funds be allocated?

**Mrs L.M. Harvey replied:**

A Building Condition Assessment (BCA) of each public school was undertaken in the second half of 2013. The BCA process identifies and prioritises the maintenance items, including minor non-urgent work.

- (a) At the time of inspection in 2013, the estimated value of identified maintenance work at Banksia Grove Primary School was \$19,081.
- (b) [See tabled paper no 4155.]. Note that Banksia Grove Primary School was formerly known as Neerabup Primary School. The BCA report describes the site as Neerabup Primary School.
- (c) Since the 2013 BCA was undertaken, \$192,671 has been spent on maintenance at Banksia Grove Primary School.
