

GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES — MEDIA, COMMUNICATIONS AND  
MARKETING

**48. Mr M. McGowan to the Minister for Police; Road Safety; Small Business; Women's Interests:**

I refer to each department and agency under the Minister's control and ask, as at 15 April 2013:

- (a) what is the total number of employees engaged in media, communications, marketing or speechwriting, including:
  - (i) public;
  - (ii) corporate; and
  - (iii) media relations;
- (b) what is the salary of each of these employees; and
- (c) what is the job title for each of these employees?

**Mrs L.M. Harvey replied:**

Police:

- (a) As at 15 April 2013, there are 17 employees (17 FTE) engaged in media, communications, marketing or speechwriting.
- (b)–(c) [See paper 310.]

Road Safety:

- (a)–(c) The Office of Road Safety is administratively supported as part of Main Roads WA and as such the response will be included in the Main Roads WA response under the Minister for Transport.

Small Business:

- (a) As at 15 April 2013, there are five (5) employees (4.4 FTE) engaged in media, communications, marketing or speech writing.

Women's Interests:

- (a)–(c) Administrative support for the Women's Interests portfolio is provided through the Department for Communities and as such the response will be included in the Minister for Communities response.
