

CHILD PROTECTION — CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE — ROEBOURNE

**66. Hon NICK GOIRAN to the Leader of the House representing the Minister for Child Protection:**

I refer to the answer to my question without notice 5 on 12 February 2019, in which the minister advised the house that in each instance in which a young person charged with or convicted of a sexual offence attends a public school, every case is monitored, assessed and managed by the Department of Communities.

- (1) As the school year is now underway, how many such cases is the department currently monitoring?
- (2) Does the department also monitor such cases in which the young person attends a private school?
