

MIDLAND TRAIN STATION — RELOCATION

**886. Hon ALISON XAMON to the minister representing the Minister for Transport:**

I refer to the answer to my question on notice 5652. In light of the commitment the Premier made on 19 October at the Swan Chamber of Commerce breakfast to a new Midland train station located closer to the new Midland hospital —

- (1) What is the department's planned time line for each stage of designing and building the new Midland train station and bus interchange?
- (2) Will the minister please identify which, if any, stages of the design and development process will be sent out for tender?
- (3) Will the minister commit to having the promised new train station functional and open by the time the new hospital opens?

**Hon SIMON O'BRIEN replied:**

I thank the honourable member for some notice of this question.

The Public Transport Authority advises —

- (1) There is no time line at present, as the scope of work is yet to be finalised.
- (2) This will be dependent on the final scope of the project.
